Dear Mr Sampson,

We are writing to you to request a positional statement from the Civil Nuclear Police Authority Management Board in relation to the following matters:

You will be aware of the decision of the recent Police Arbitration Tribunal (PAT) in relation to the Winsor Report Part 1 published in January 2012, and the recommendations provided by this body from the independent review of Police Officer remuneration and conditions of service which came from within the remit of the Police Negotiating Board (PNB)

Historically as you will be aware our Constabulary have adopted those recommendations evolving from PNB agreements, in relation to remuneration and conditions of service of Police Officers flowing out of that pay review body.

In making this request, we are conscious of the responsibility of our employers in relation to government, administration, and conditions of service which are set out in the Energy Act 2004 C3 - s58 (1)

In the absence of any other process or agreed framework currently being in place or being formally proposed by the Civil Nuclear Police Authority

( CNPA ) , to the Civil Nuclear Police Federation ( CNPF ) , and approved by our sponsoring department, the Department of Energy and Climate Change (DECC), at this current time, we seek to be provided with a “Positional Statement” by our employers on how they wish to proceed on matters arising from the recommendations of the PAT on the issues I have set out in this correspondence

During a period of uncertainty felt by our members in relation to the future of CNC federated ranks remuneration and conditions of Service and CNC ACPO declared commitment to transparency and fairness in relation to such issues, we trust that the CNPA Management board will deal with this request with a sense of urgency?
